

Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

1. This campaign is known as “Everyday NMR 3” (the “Prize Draw”) and the prize to be awarded is an **Apple AirPods Pro** (“Prize”).

The Prize Draw will close on **12 July 2023 at 20:30 BST**. Prize draw will take place on **13 July 2023 at 10:15 – 10:45 BST at the Venue**. Oxford Instruments reserves the right to change the dates and Venue without notice at any time.
4. Unless otherwise stated, the Prize Draw is open to residents worldwide. Entrants must be 18 years or over to enter the Prize Draw.
